

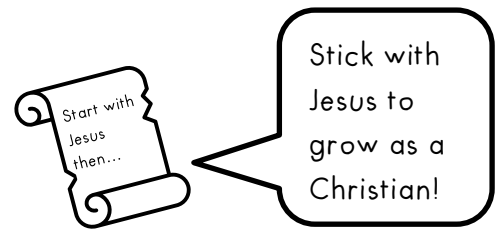
BIG IDEA: Colossians 2:6-15

You won't be surprised but Paul's big point is: you are complete in Christ. Don't look elsewhere for things to help you grow. All you need is Jesus, and you have him!!

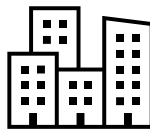

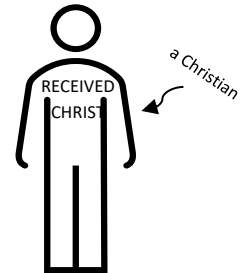
