<u>V24</u>

What present certainty and future assurance does this lead to for those who trust Jesus?

<u>V25-30</u>

What does Jesus say has now come? What is still to come? How are they linked?

Thinking it through

Jesus expect us to be amazed (v20) and not amazed (v28). As we consider Jesus' relationship with the Father and the role He has been given, what A) fills your heart with awe?

B) leads us to fuller assurance?

What implications does understanding what Jesus is saying here have for our evangelism?
